### Sports Premium Statement

After the Government announced it would be investing £150 million into school sport, Herne CE Junior School have been busy planning how to spend the money. Our school is guaranteed approximately £9,000 for the next few years, which we will spend in a sustainable and effective way which will improve our long term provision of PE (Physical Education in the curriculum) and school sport (extra-curricular sporting opportunities). Half of the money we will receive has been funded by the Department of Health and therefore will also be used to improve opportunities for all children to adopt healthy lifestyles.

### 2015-2016 Review

- 65% of Pupil Premium attended a sports club this academic year
- Overall, 78% of children attended at least one sports club in this academic year
- Our staff were supported in delivering quality PE lessons through staff meetings, 1:1 support, team teaching, staff meetings from the PE leader and twilight training supplied by HBH.
- A club level coach was employed to teach every child hockey for 6 weeks.
- Gold Kitemark achieved
- We promote the School Games through our school twitter account, assemblies, newsletters, blog on school website, displays in corridors.
- 3 of our nominations for sports awards were short-listed for the Coastal Alliance's awards, with one outright winner - Year 5/6 Basketball team won Team of the Year
- New equipment purchased.
- By purchasing the enhanced package at HBH we:
  - Received 1:1 support for our NQT for teaching gymnastics (6 hours)
  - Entered 11 interschool competitions and won 4 of them. The 4 winning teams have represented the Herne Bay area. Two teams (Basketball and Cricket) won, and were crowned County Champions

- Had our playground play leader and 14 sports crew members trained to deliver intra school competitions on the playground. They ran
- intraschool competitions on the playground daily.
- PE leader support including 2 PE leader meetings and netball CPD.
- Implemented a new club (dance mats) using high school facilities.

### Enhanced Package HBHS 2016-2017

1. Level 1/ intra school competition training and delivery (sports crew).
  - Level 2/ inter-sports competitions
  - Level 3 county competitions should our children qualify
  - Support for PE leader
  - Links with other schools
  - Subsidized Bikeability training for year 5 and 6
  
2. Maintain high quality equipment
  - Purchase more basketballs so there is a class set available.
  - Replace all hockey sticks
  - Use Sainsbury's vouchers to replenish play time equipment.
  
3. Employ Mr Marks to demonstrate, support and team teach games in PE lessons (every class).

### Mr Marks

- Use of Sports Premium funding to employ Mr Marks for four afternoons per week, including running sports clubs after school on each of those days.
- Mr Marks will be teaching 2 classes per year group each afternoon, and will work in conjunction with class teachers to ensure the P.E curriculum is covered extensively and successfully.
- Mr Marks will contribute to P.E assessment data for all children twice a year.
- He will have regular contact with the PE co-ordinator and head-teacher
- He will keep a running inventory of PE equipment, notifying the PE co-ordinator if new equipment needs purchasing
